LEAs staged in one or more program areas for 2017-18 will engage in the TAIS continuous improvement process to develop a Targeted Improvement Plan (TIP) that is focused on areas of low performance and systemic and programmatic improvement needs.

Intervention requirements for LEAs staged for PBMAS

- Stage 1 – 4: Identify District Coordinator for School Improvement (DCSI) and establish a District Leadership Team (DLT).
- Stage 1 – 4: Engage in the Texas Accountability Intervention System (TAIS) process for all PBM indicators assigned a Performance Level 2, 3, or 4.
- Stage 1 & 2: District will retain TIP locally (unless also an Improvement Required LEA or selected for random submission).
- Stage 3 & 4: District will submit TIP to TEA by November 17, 2017.

Teachers who pass the exam will receive a Gifted and Talented Certification. This certification is not required by the state of Texas for teachers of the gifted. Teachers who take this test currently do so on a voluntary basis. The state currently requires that teachers who provide services to the gifted must complete 30 hours of G/T professional development in nature and needs of the gifted, assessment of the gifted, and curriculum for the gifted.

The content on the G/T Supplemental test is derived from the G/T standards. Those standards are listed on the SBEC website under the Standards and Testing link. The test is a multiple choice test. Also on the SBEC website is a study guide with sample questions.
