Session name: **Effective Decoding and Spelling Instruction for Students with Disabilities**

Description: This is a two-day streamed video workshop, with Virginia Gonzalez and will assist teachers with all struggling learners in all settings/grades. Virginia is a diagnostician for dyslexia services and has also served as the Texas State Dyslexia Consultant.

Day one will focus on the two significant factors in acquiring literacy: decoding and spelling. A framework for a decoding-spelling continuum will be presented. Instructional strategies and activities will also be presented that will reinforce concepts and skills for students performing below grade level.

Day two will further build on participants' understanding of how English spelling works. This session will explain the five principles for understanding English orthography when spelling. Understanding these five principles will provide students with a structure and plan for decoding and spelling unknown words.
